Market Spaces:

Spaces are assigned by the market manager. Check-in with the manager upon arrival each market day. If a vendor is assigned a <u>reserved</u> space based on seniority and <u>three</u> consecutive market days are missed once that vendor's market season starts, the reserved space will be reassigned to another vendor.

✓ Vendors Responsibilities:

Bring fresh, quality products to the market.

Must be in full compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws & regulations. All required Wisconsin State licenses and permits are to be obtained by the vendors and copies are to be filed with the market manager.

Vendors are responsible for their own personal and product liability insurance.

Do not bring your pets to the market.

Clean up assigned space after each market day.

Violations:

Violation of any of the rules, responsibilities or regulations may result in that vendor being barred from further participation in the market.
